**ORDER**

On March 29, 2006 this cause came on for hearing before the Court. Janet Kennedy appeared *pro se*. Bobby Joe Kennedy appeared in person and by his attorney J. Terry Weeks. Having considered the evidence and the applicable law, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction and venue is proper in Hays County.

The Court finds and holds that Janet Kennedy is a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 (2) and (3) of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code of the State of Texas. The Court grants and orders a prefiling order pursuant to the statute. Janet Kennedy is prohibited from filing any case in the State of Texas without first securing the permission of the local administrative judge.

The Court further orders that Janet Kennedy post as security for the benefit of Bobby Joe Kennedy, for his costs and expenses in this litigation as provided by the statute in the amount of \$25,000.00, on or before May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2006. Should Ms. Kennedy fail to give security for costs as ordered herein, her claims will be dismissed
