
The Court considered the Affidavit of Voluntary Resignation of:





NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT


I, Katherine Bearden, am no longer in possession of my law license or bar card. They were lost or stolen at one point and have never been found.

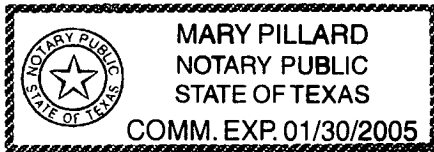
