IV.

In the fall of 1990, Glen Petta ("Petta") employed Respondent to implement, administer and maintain an Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP) for Petta's business. The ESOP was established in February of 1991. In 1996, an examiner from the Internal Revenue Service's Employee Plans Division audited the plan. The examiner referred the matter to the U.S. Department of Labor, which conducted an audit. Petta and Respondent met with the auditor in April of 1997.

V.

Following the meeting with the U.S. Department of Labor, Respondent failed to clearly communicate to Petta that Respondent had not been retained to assist Petta further in the DOL matter. As a result, Petta had to obtain an extension of time to respond to the U.S. Department of Labor and to obtain other counsel.

VI.

Such acts and/or omissions on the part of Respondent as are described in Paragraphs IV and V, hereinabove, which occurred on or after January 1, 1990, constitute conduct which violates Rule 1.01(b) of the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct.

VIII.

The complaint which forms the basis of the Cause of Action hereinabove set forth was brought to the attention of the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas by Glen Petta filing a complaint on or about August 16, 1999.
