I submit the following affidavit in support of my resignation:



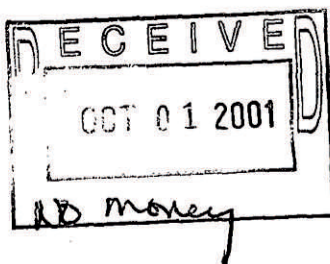


