Amendment to the Standards and Rules for Certification of Shorthand Reporters

IT IS ORDERED by the Supreme Court of Texas that the following amendment to Rule VI (C), Fees, of the *Standards and Rules for Certification of Certified Shorthand Reporters* is adopted and promulgated in conformity with Chapter 52 of the Texas Government Code as follows:

(C) Renewal Fee. A total fee of two hundred ten (\$210) dollars, shall be paid on or before the expiration date of the certification. Unless this fee is timely paid or the certification reinstated as provided in Rule 1.E., the certification previously issued shall expire at the date of the second anniversary of the date of the issuance of the certification. Ten (\$10) dollars of the renewal fee represents a subscription fee to be collected from licensees to fund a common Internet licensing system, pursuant to SB 645, effective Sept. 1, 2001.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Supreme Court approves the fee increase and this amended Rule VI (C) becomes effective September 1, 2002.
