
The approval of these rules is temporary, pending further orders of the Court.



AMENDMENT TO LOCAL RULES OF THE DISTRICT COURTS, THE COUNTY COURTS
AT LAW, AND THE PROBATE AND COUNTY COURT OF
GALVESTON COUNTY, TEXAS

In accordance with Rule 11 entitled "Amendment of Rules", the Local Rules of the District Courts of Galveston County, Texas, adopted on the 2nd day of December, 1988, are hereby amended as follows:


Pursuant to 24.601 (b) of the Government Code, Section 4.1 of the Local Rules of the District Courts of Galveston County, Texas adopted on the 2nd day of December, 1988, is hereby amended to read as follows:

RULE 4. DISPOSITION OF FAMILY LAW AND JUVENILE CASES.


4.1 General. All suits authorized under the Family Code shall be filed by order of the 306th Family District Court.

The District Clerk is directed to furnish a copy of these amendments of the Local Rules to the Supreme Court of Texas, pursuant to Rule 817 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure and to record these rules in the Civil Minutes of the 10th, 56th, 122nd, 212th and 306th District Courts.


