## APPOINTMENT OF SUPREME COURT PROVOST FOR JUDICIAL EDUCATION

## **ORDERED:**

For the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 1992, the Court hereby appoints Dean William W. Gibson, Jr. as the Supreme Court Provost for Judicial Education to consult with and advise the Supreme Court in the operation of the education programs for judges, court officials and personnel, and in developing curriculum and programs to enhance the system of judicial education in Texas.

Dean Gibson is directed to aid in curriculum and program development for, and to explore the opportunities for joint efforts among and the exchange of information between, the recipients of judicial and court personnel training funds, and to encourage the use of new technologies and alternatives to the traditional mode of educational programs.

All entities receiving grant funds from the judicial and court personnel training fund are directed to fully cooperate with the Supreme Court Provost for Judicial Education.

To implement this Order, the Court approves a budget of \$231,000 for the Office of the Provost for the fiscal year beginning September 1, 1992 and ending August 31, 1993.

The Office of Court Administration will continue to perform the administrative and audit functions for the Supreme Court in the judicial education area.
