
**ORDER OF THE COURT APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE 1993-1994

TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS:



**PETITION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT TO THE 1993-94
GENERAL FUND BUDGET OF THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS**

TO THE HONORABLE CHIEF JUSTICE AND JUSTICES OF SAID COURT:

The State Bar of Texas respectfully hereby petitions the Court for budget amendment.

In support hereof, the petitioner states as follows:

I

The Board of Directors of the State Bar of Texas, in a regularly called meeting on January 21, 1994, in San Antonio, Texas, at which meeting a quorum was present, moved and adopted subject to the Court's approval, an amendment to the fiscal year 1993-1994 general fund budget as follows: To increase the Officers and Directors budget by \$250,000 for the purpose of conducting and informing the membership of a referendum during the Spring of 1994, of proposed changes to the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure, and the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Rules.


WHEREFORE, the State Bar of Texas respectfully requests the Supreme Court of Texas approve this proposed amendment to its 1993-1994 budget.
