#### **DISCIPLINARY PETITION**

# TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE COURT:

The COMMISSION FOR LAWYER DISCIPLINE ("Petitioner") a permanent committee of the State Bar of Texas, pursuant to the authority of an investigatory panel for State Bar District Number 4I files this Disciplinary Petition complaining of George M. Hamm ("Respondent"), an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Texas, showing the Court as follows:

# 1. NATURE OF PROCEEDING

Petitioner brings this disciplinary action pursuant to the State Bar Act, the Texas Government Code Annotated §81.001, *et seq.* (Vernon 1988 and supp. 1994), the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct, and the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure. The complaints that form the basis of this Disciplinary Petition were filed on or after May 1, 1992.

#### 2. VENUE

Respondent is an attorney licensed to practice law in Texas and is a member of the State Bar of Texas. Respondent is a resident of Harris County, Texas. Respondent's principal place of practice is Harris County, Texas. Therefore, venue is appropriate in Harris County, Texas, pursuant to Rule 3.03 of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure.

#### 3. ISSUANCE OF CITATION REQUESTED

3.01 Petitioner requests that citation be issued and forwarded to: Jeannette Duer,

#### 4. <u>SEEGER'S COMPLAINT</u>

PURSUANT TO PART III OF THE TEXAS RULES OF DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE, PETITIONER REQUESTS THIS COURT TO DISCIPLINE HAMM FOR ACTS OF PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT.

HAMM ENGAGED IN CONDUCT VIOLATING TEXAS DISCIPLINARY RULE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT 1.02(a) [A lawyer shall abide by a client's decisions: (1) concerning the objectives and general methods of representation; and (2) whether to accept an offer of settlement of a matter, except as otherwise authorized by law].

(A) On or about November 20, 1995, John R. Seeger ("Complainant"), retained

George M. Hamm ("Respondent") for representation in correcting a

previously issued Qualified Domestic Relations Order ("QDRO").

- (B) Complainant had given Respondent explicit instructions as to corrections regarding the QDRO.
- (C) Respondent failed to comply with Complaint's instructions regarding corrections to the QDRO.

- (D) Respondent entered into an agreement with opposing counsel without Complainant's knowledge or consent.
- (E) The agreement entered into by Respondent resulted in harm to Respondent's client, the Complainant.

## 5.0 PRAYER

Petitioner respectfully prays that this Court discipline Respondent by disbarment, suspension or reprimand, as the facts shall warrant; and that the Petitioner have all other relief to which it may show itself to be justly entitled including costs of court and attorneys' fees.
