With reference to your letter of July 1, 1999, enclosing 1999-00 Dues Statement retaining my inactive status, this is to advise you that I am hereby resigning from the State Bar of Texas.

I was an active member of the Texas Bar from about 1960 until 1966 when I was a member of the Humble (now Exxon) Law Department; I was transferred by Humble to New York City in 1966 and thereafter practiced law under my New York Law License as a member of the Exxon Law Department until 1982, and with the Church & Dwight Law Department until 1988 when I retired and thereafter no longer practiced law.
