Invited Testimony

Judge Mark Davidson discussed the process of electing judges within Texas and strong dependence on the party system, identified discretionary judicial voters (DJV), who represent voters capable of voting for judges of either party, and the differences between voters in rural and urban areas. Judge Davidson also outlined the election process and controversy in funding elections for judges. He also presented alternative methods to the current election process.

Presentations

Angela Garcia, Chief Data Officer for the Office of Court Administration presented demographics and turnover data for the Texas judiciary, and discussed past and current elections and length of service of Texas Judges.

Dr. Mark P. Jones from the Baker Institute for Public Police at Rice University reviewed the many methods of selecting Judges within the United States and Texas and discussed the advantages and disadvantages of each.
