

ORDER CORRECTING AMENDMENTS TO TEXAS RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE AND TEXAS DISCIPLINARY RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT


ORDERED that:

1. The amendments to the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure promulgated by Order dated December 23, 2020, in Misc. Dkt. No. 20-9153, are corrected as follows:
 - a. In the comment to Rule 190, the reference to “deposition” is changed to “depositions.”
 - b. In Rule 197.3, the reference to “Rule 194.2(c) and (d)” is changed to “Rule 194.2(b)(3) and (b)(4).”
2. The amendments to the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct promulgated by Order dated May 25, 2021, in Misc. Dkt. No. 21-9061, are corrected as follows: In Comment 8 to Rule 1.16, the reference to “Texas Probate Code” is changed to “Texas Estates Code.”
3. These changes are effective September 1, 2021.

 - b. cause a copy of this Order to be mailed to each registered member of the State Bar of Texas by publication in the *Texas Bar Journal*;

 - d. submit a copy of the Order for publication in the *Texas Register*.


