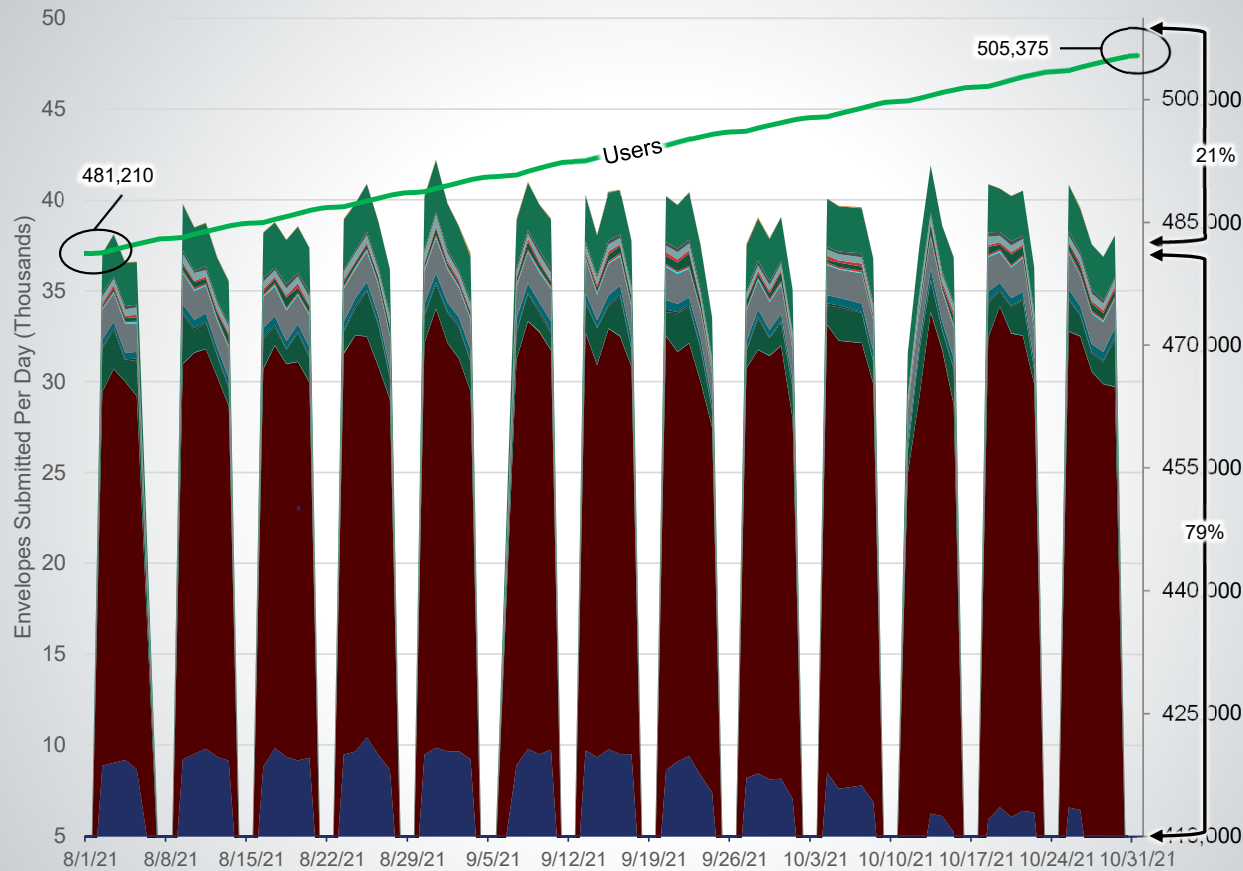

Transaction Volume: 8/1/21 to 10/31/21



- **Over half a million user accounts** created to-date
- EFM currently receiving **~39,000 envelopes per day**
- State filing portal accounts for 79% of transactions; remaining 21% stem from commercial EFSP submissions

TX E-Filing: JP

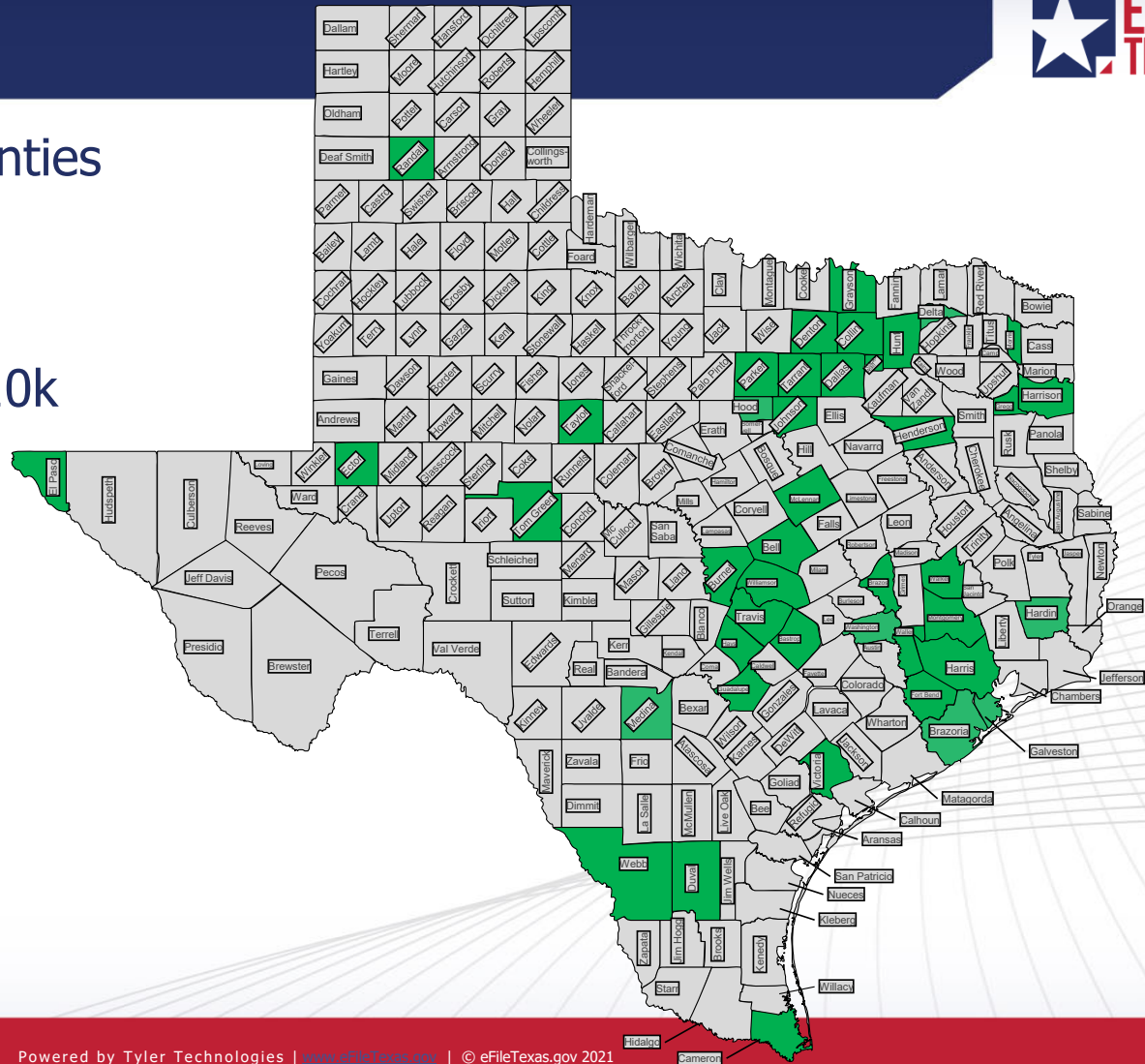


- 166 precincts across 43 counties are live
 - 6 active engagements
 - 7 engagements pending
- JPs contribute more than 110k filings per month

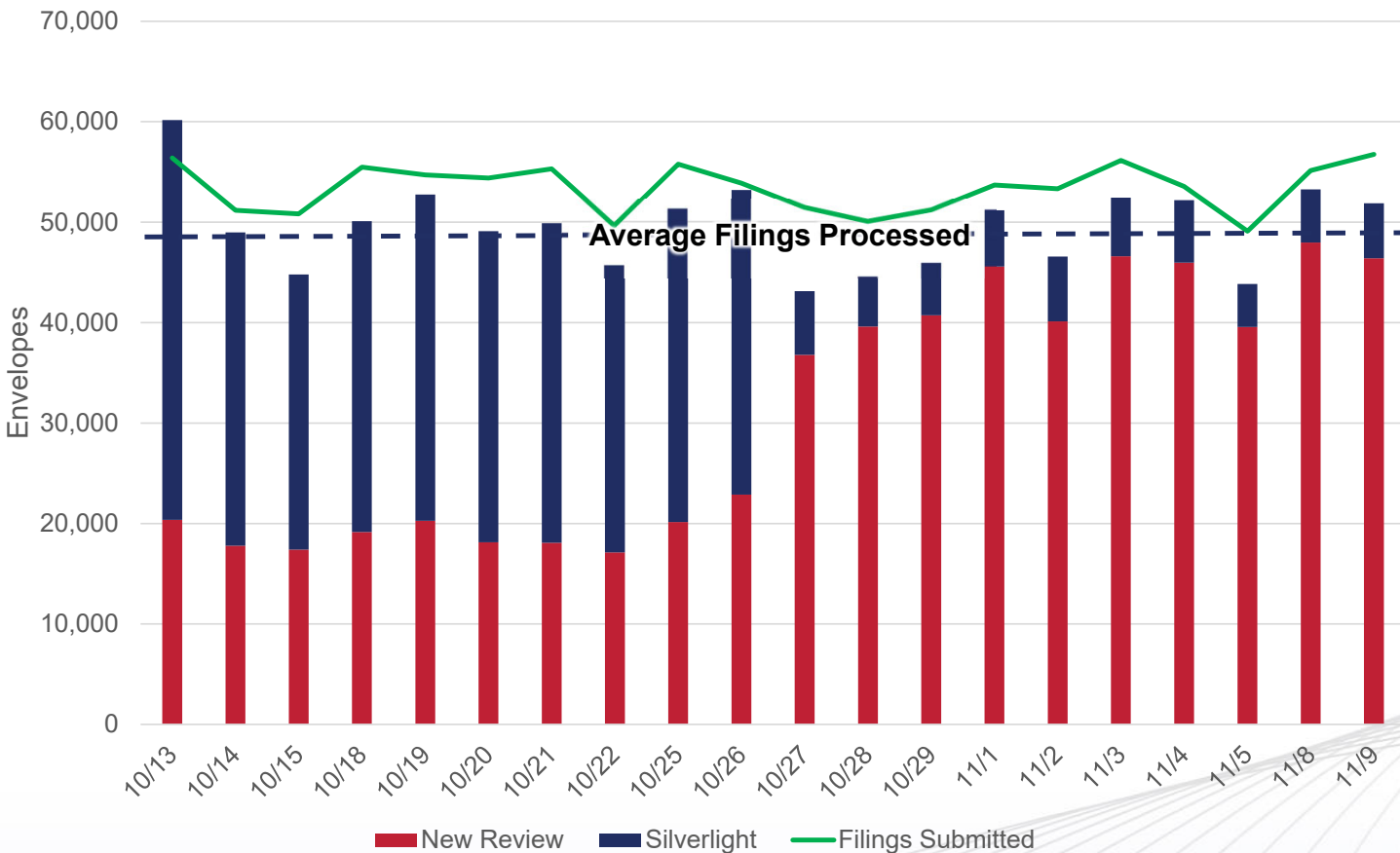
***Note:** Not all live counties are live with all precincts

New Review Tool Implementation



New Review Tool implemented in Texas, driven by MS Silverlight support deprecation

Clerks have acclimated well to new solution

Duration	% Reviewed in < 24 Hours
Jan - Sep	90.97%
Oct	88.96%

- **Top 10 Populous Counties = 89%**
- **Not Top 10 Counties = 91%**

Support volume increased with new solution, but rapid delivery model means **faster issue resolution and feature enrichment**

Solution sets foundation for eFileTexas 2.0 development projects

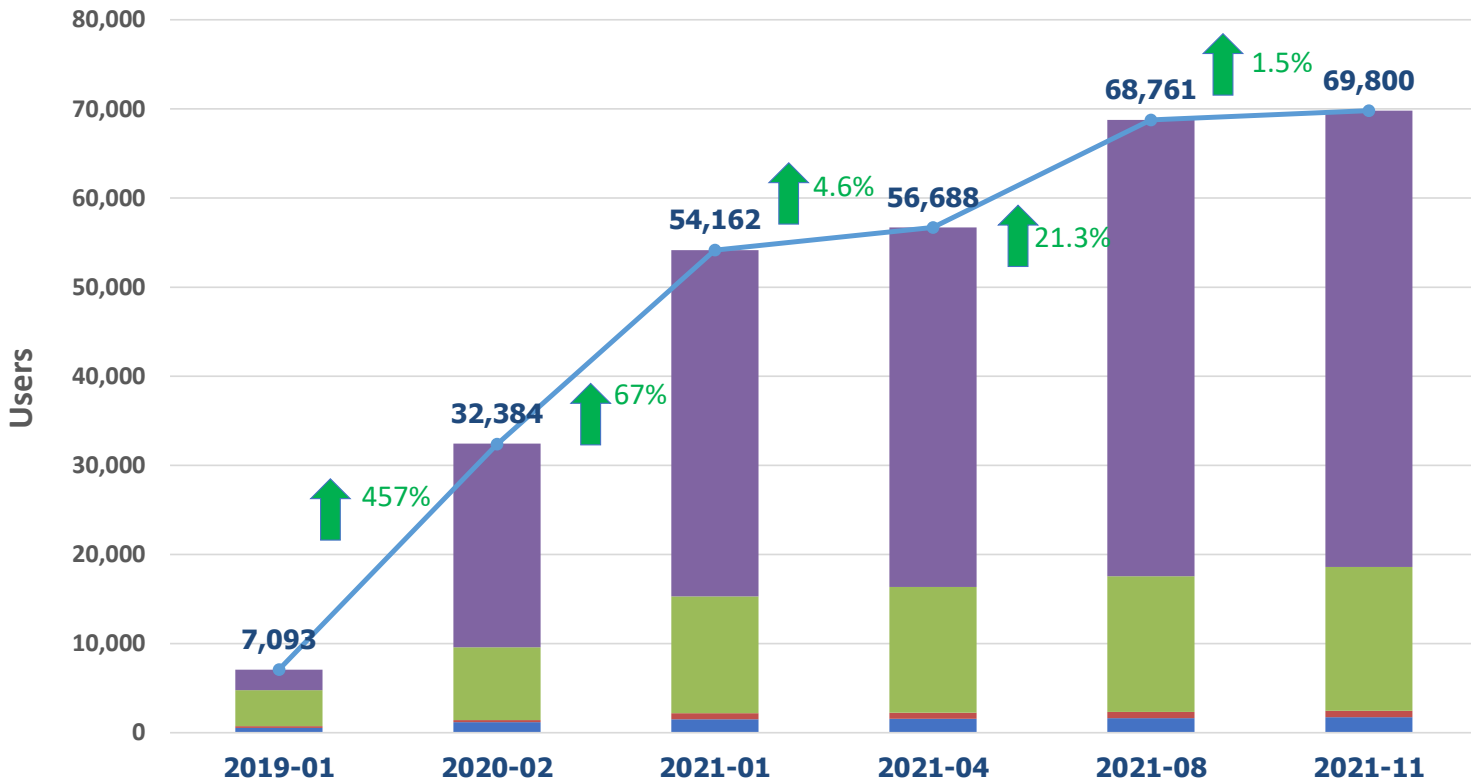
eFileTexas 2.0 – Progress Update



- Cycle 1 Execution phase is 68% complete
- Testing is 58% complete
 - User Acceptance testing for "OOTB" items currently underway
- eFile Analytics Pilot Testing is 75% complete

- Cycle 2 analysis and design is complete
- Cycle 2 execution phase to begin on 12/20

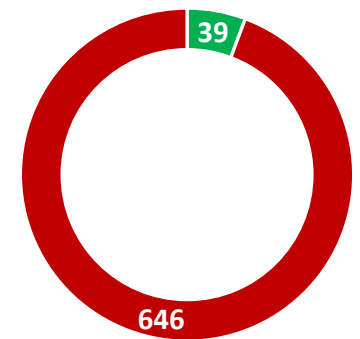
