
**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE

~~IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff is hereby declared to be a vexatious litigant, and Plaintiff is ordered to obtain and post a bond in the amount of \$ _____ by August __, 2009, to guarantee payment to Defendant for reasonable expenses, including its costs and attorneys' fees incurred in the defense of this lawsuit. If Plaintiff does not furnish the security within the time set by this Order, the Court will dismiss this litigation with prejudice.~~

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any new litigation in a court in this State without first being granted written permission to do so by the ~~local administrative~~ ^{presiding} judge of the court in which Plaintiff would file such new litigation. All relief not specifically granted herein is expressly denied.
