It is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff Luis Lagaite, Jr., TDCJ-ID No. 762508, is hereby DETERMINED TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT pursuant to TEXAS CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE § 11.054 and § 11.101, respectively.

THEREFORE, Plaintiff is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 750.00. The amount must be furnished to the Court by October 15, 2011. Should Plaintiff fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is DISMISSED.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing any new litigation *in propria persona* in the State of Texas without prior permission of the local administrative judge, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code §§11.051 – 11.057.
