**EMERGENCY ORDER EXEMPTING BAR EXAM APPLICANTS
DISPLACED BY HURRICANE KATRINA FROM PAYING CERTAIN LATE FEES**

ORDERED that:


Notwithstanding the *Rules Governing Admission to the Bar of Texas*, an applicant for the February 2006 Texas Bar Examination, who is from Louisiana, Mississippi or Alabama and displaced due to Hurricane Katrina, is exempt from paying the late fee that would otherwise apply to applications filed between August 30, 2005, and October 30, 2005. The October 30, 2005, filing deadline for the February 2006 Bar Examination is not intended to be affected by this order.




