ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS

MISC. DOCKET No. 05- 9229

IN THE MATTER OF DONALD J. LARGE

The Court has reviewed the Motion for Acceptance of Resignation as Attorney and Counselor at Law in Lieu of Disciplinary Action of Donald J. Large and the Response of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel for the Commission for Lawyer Discipline. The Court concludes each meets the requirements of Part X of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure. In the absence of a request by Donald J. Large to withdraw his Motion for Acceptance of Resignation as Attorney and Counselor at Law in Lieu of Disciplinary Action, the Court deems the professional misconduct detailed in the Response of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel for the Commission for Lawyer Discipline conclusively established for all purposes. The Court further concludes that acceptance of Donald J. Large's resignation is in the best interest of the public and the profession. Therefore, the law license of Donald J. Large of Harris County, Texas, State Bar Number 24026980, is canceled.

Donald J. Large is prohibited from practicing law in the State of Texas. This includes holding himself out as attorney at law, performing legal services for others, giving legal advice to others, accepting any fee directly or indirectly for legal services, appearing as counsel or in any representative capacity in any proceeding in any Texas court or before any Texas administrative body (whether state, county, municipal, or other), or holding himself out to others or using his name in any manner in conjunction with the "Attorney at Law," "Counselor at Law," or "Lawyer."

Donald J. Large must immediately notify in writing each of his current clients of this resignation. Donald J. Large shall also return any files, papers, unearned monies, and other property

in his possession and belonging to any client, to the respective client or to another attorney at the client's request. Donald J. Large shall file with the STATE BAR OF TEXAS, Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, P.O. Box 12487, Austin, Texas 78711-2487, within thirty (30) days of the date of this *Order* an affidavit stating that all current clients have been notified of his resignation and that all files, papers, monies, and other property belonging to all clients have been returned.

Additionally, Donald J. Large shall, within thirty (30) days of this *Order*, notify in writing each justice of the peace, judge, magistrate, and chief justice of each court in which he has any matter pending of the terms of this *Order*; the style and cause number of the pending matter(s); and the name, address and telephone number of the client(s) he is representing in that court. Donald J. Large shall file with the **STATE BAR OF TEXAS**, **Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel**, **P.O. Box 12487**, **Austin**, **Texas 78711-2487**, within thirty (30) days of the date of this *Order*, an affidavit stating that he has notified in writing each justice of the peace, judge, magistrate, and chief justice of each court in which he has any matter pending of the terms of this *Order*; the style and cause number of the pending matter(s); and the name, address and telephone number of the client(s) he is representing in that court.

Donald J. Large shall pay restitution to Roberto R. Molina in the amount of in the amount of One Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00), plus applicable interest. Payment of this restitution is an absolute condition precedent to reinstatement. In the event that the STATE BAR OF TEXAS CLIENT SECURITY FUND shall have made any payment to Roberto R. Molina, then Respondent shall pay to the STATE BAR OF TEXAS the amount paid. If the amount paid by the CLIENT SECURITY FUND is less than the full amount of restitution owed, then any amount remaining shall be

paid to Roberto R. Molina, as set forth above. All payments shall be made by certified or cashier's check and delivered to the STATE BAR OF TEXAS, Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, P.O. Box 12487, Austin, Texas 78711-2487.

Donald J. Large shall pay attorneys' fees to the STATE BAR OF TEXAS in the amount of in the amount of One Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00), plus applicable interest, as a condition precedent to reinstatement. All payments should be made by certified or cashier's check and delivered to the STATE BAR OF TEXAS, Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, P.O. Box 12487, Austin, Texas 78711-2487.
