## TRANSFER OF CASES FROM FIRST COURT OF APPEALS

---

### **ORDERED:**

The first 50 civil and criminal cases, except as otherwise provided by this Order, which are filed in the Court of Appeals for the First Court of Appeals District, Houston, Texas, on or after June 17, 1991, are transferred to the Court of Appeals for the Sixth Court of Appeals District, Texarkana, Texas.

The next 35 civil and criminal cases, except as otherwise provided by this Order, which are filed in the Court of Appeals for the First Court of Appeals District, Houston, Texas, on or after June 17, 1991, are transferred to the Court of Appeals for the Eighth Court of Appeals District, El Paso, Texas.

The next 15 civil cases, and the next 35 criminal cases, except as otherwise provided by this Order, which are filed in the Court of Appeals for the First Court of Appeals District, Houston, Texas, on or after June 17, 1991, are transferred to the Court of Appeals for the Thirteenth Court of Appeals District, Corpus Christi, Texas.


In effectuating this Order, companion cases shall either all be transferred, or shall all be retained by the Court in which filed, as determined by the Chief Justice of the transferring Court.

It is specifically provided that the cases ordered transferred by this Order shall, in each instance, not include original proceedings, appeals from interlocutory orders, appeals from denial of writs of habeas corpus, extradition, bond cases, and those cases which in the opinion of the Chief Justice of the transferring Court contain extraordinary circumstances or in which emergency action may be required.


The Court of Appeals for the First Court of Appeals District will make the necessary orders for the transfer of said cases as directed hereby, and will cause the Clerk of that Court to transfer the original transcript and all filed papers in each case, and certify all Orders made, to the Court of Appeals to which the cases are transferred. Upon completion of the transfer of the requisite number of cases ordered transferred, the transferring Court shall submit a list of the cases transferred, identified by style and number, to the Supreme Court and the State Office of Court Administration.






