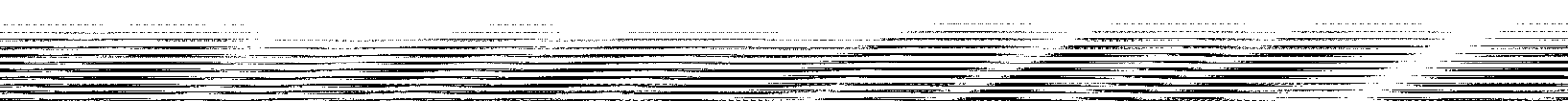

DISCIPLINARY PETITION

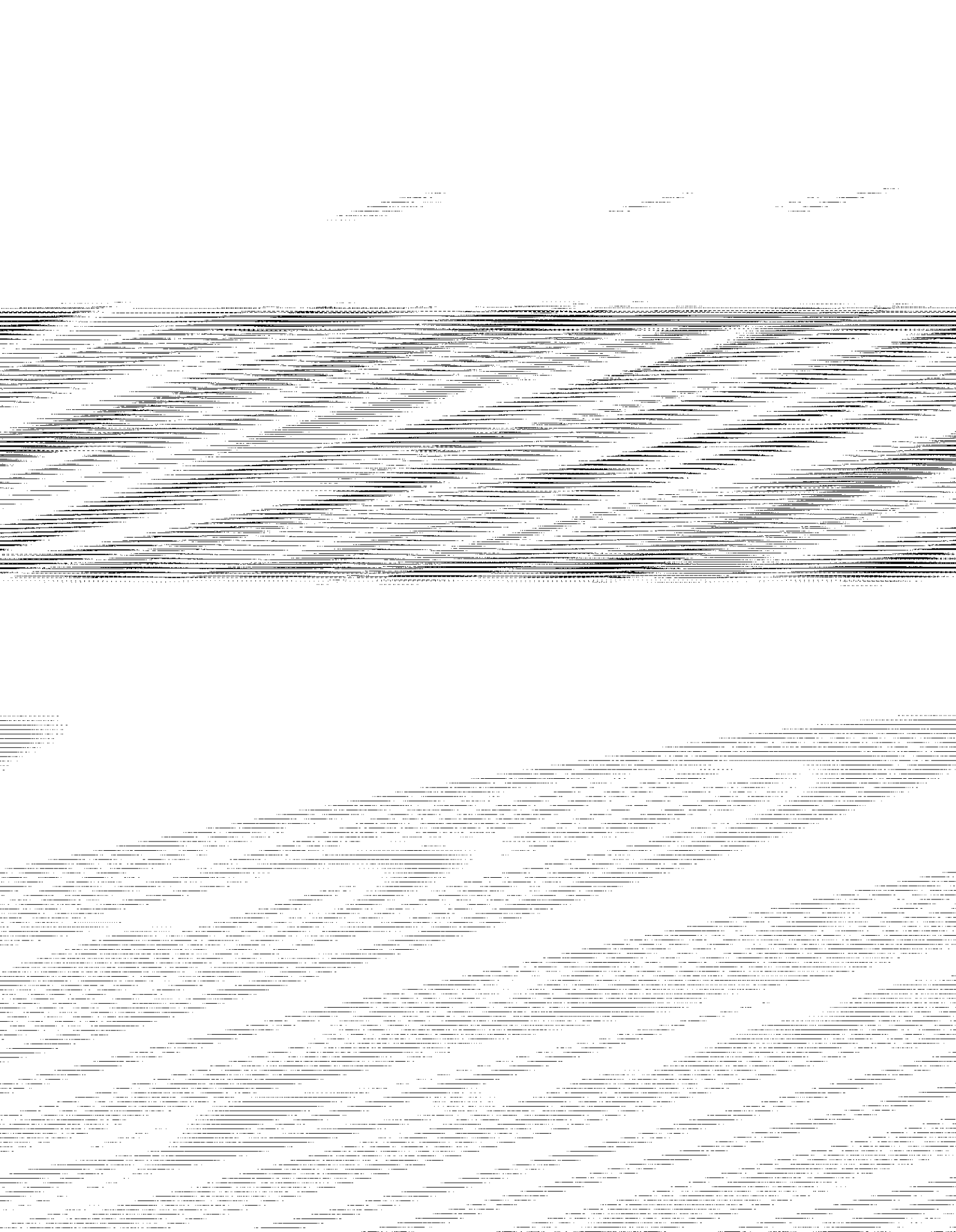
