**Order Granting
Defendant's Motion for Vexatious-Litigant Finding and
Requirement to Post Security**

The Court finds that there is not a reasonable probability that Kelechi Okere will prevail in the litigation. The Court further finds that Kelechi Okere has—within the proceeding seven years—filed at least five lawsuits that were finally determined adversely to him. Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054(1). In light of these findings:

IT IS ORDERED that Kelechi Okere is declared a vexatious litigant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Kelechi Okere must post security in the amount of \$10,000 within ten days of the date of this order. Should he fail to do so, this case will be dismissed. This security is to assure

payment to the defendant of reasonable expenses incurred with this litigation (including costs and attorney's fees).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Kelechi Okere may not file, prosecute, any litigation in any Texas state court without advance permission of the local administrative judge of such court.
