**ORDER GRANTING CITY OF DALLAS'S MOTION TO DECLARE
ANGELOS KOLOBOTOS A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

On this day, came to be heard the City of Dallas's Motion to Declare Angelos Kolobotos a Vexatious Litigant filed on April 15, 2021 and City of Dallas's Supplement to Motion to Declare Angelos Kolobotos a Vexatious Litigant filed on May 20, 2021. The Court has considered the pleadings, evidence, applicable authorities, and arguments of counsel, and determined that the motion and its supplement are well taken and should be **GRANTED**. Specifically, the Court finds:

1. There is no reasonable probability that Plaintiffs will prevail in this litigation;
2. Prior litigation between Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos and the City of Dallas has been finally determined against Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos, significantly for the purposes of this motion in Case No. DC-20-02502; and
3. Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos attempted to relitigate the same cause of action that was finally determined in Case No. DC-20-02502 in this litigation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos is a "vexatious litigant" as defined in chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos is prohibited from filing any new litigation on behalf of himself or others in any court in this state against the City of Dallas or any employees of the City of Dallas, including without limitation Andrew Gilbert and Chanlor Akins, without first obtaining permission of the appropriate local administrative judge, as provided by section 11.102 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Upon requesting any such permission, Plaintiff Angelos Kolobotos is ordered to provide a copy of the request to all defendants named in the proposed litigation;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System within 30 days of its signing, pursuant to section 11.104(b) of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Office of Court Administration shall identify Plaintiff as a vexatious litigant on its website pursuant to section 11.104(c) of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
