**ORDER ON DEFENDANT’S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

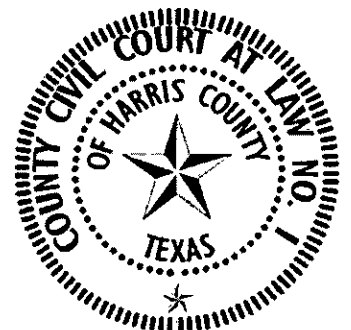
~~DENIES~~ the Motion *[Signature]*

GRANTS the motion, declares Plaintiff a vexatious litigant and orders as follows:

1. Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of Defendants, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of \$ 7500 in the form of cash or cashiers check by 9/5/2023. The security is to assure payment to the defendant for reasonable expenses, including their court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.
2. If Plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
3. This suit will remain in abatement until Plaintiff complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.
4. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).


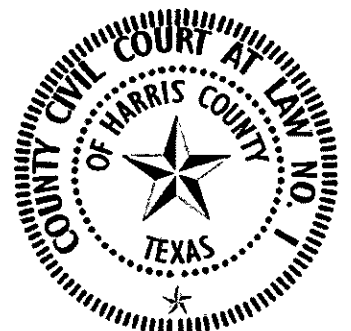
