

STATEWIDE CLEARANCE RATES




- Family courts experienced the highest clearance rates, reaching 107 percent.








STATEWIDE CLEARANCE RATES





- Family courts experienced the highest clearance rates, reaching 105 percent.










Juvenile Active Pending Cases
