OPINION

This is an appeal from an order granting appellee's special appearance which was signed on March 22, 1999. Appellant's notice of appeal was filed late, but appellant requested and received and extension of time. The clerk's record was not filed timely, and on October 15, 1999, appellee moved to dismiss the appeal because appellant had not paid for or made arrangements to pay for the preparation of the clerk's record.
