MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from an interlocutory order granting a temporary injunction signed August 14, 2000. The trial court subsequently signed a final judgment, which has been separately appealed under Appeal No. 14-00-01300-CV. The Court granted appellant's motion to consolidate this appeal with the appeal of the final judgment. To date, the filing fee of \$125.00 has not been paid in this appeal. Therefore, on February 8, 2001, the Court issued an order stating that unless appellant paid the appellate filing fee of \$125.00 within fifteen days of the date of the order, the appeal would be dismissed.

The filing fee has not been paid, and appellant has not responded to the Court's order of February 8, 2001.

Accordingly, we dissolve the order granting consolidation, and this appeal is ordered dismissed. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c).
