OPINION

This is an appeal from a judgment signed January 15, 1999. Neither the clerk's record nor the reporter's record were filed. No brief was filed. On December 30, 1999, the Clerk of this Court notified appellant that the clerk's record had not been filed, and that the district clerk's office had notified the court that no arrangements had been made for payment for the record. The clerk informed appellant that the appeal would be dismissed unless appellant filed a response within fifteen days. No response was filed.

On April 5, 2000, the district clerk's office notified this Court that payment had still not been made

for the record. On April 6, 2000, appellees filed a motion to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(b). Appellant filed no response.

Accordingly, appellees' motion is granted, and the appeal is ordered dismissed.
