MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an appeal from a judgment signed April 9, 2001. No clerk's record has been filed. The clerk responsible for preparing the record in this appeal informed the court appellant did not make arrangements to pay for the record.

On August 14, 2001, notification was transmitted to all parties of the Court's intent to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless, within fifteen days, appellant paid or made arrangements to pay for the record and provided this court with proof of payment. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b).

On August 21, 2001, appellant filed a letter stating she had received the notice. In the same letter, appellant also asked this Court to dismiss the appeal.

Accordingly, the appeal is ordered dismissed.
