MEMORANDUM OPINION

After a guilty plea, appellant was convicted of the offense of aggravated robbery, and sentenced to five years confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice--Institutional Division on October 27, 2000.

On August 16, 2001, this court ordered a hearing to determine why appellant's counsel had not filed a brief in this appeal. On August 28, 2001, the trial court conducted the hearing. The record of the hearing was filed in this court on August 29, 2001.

The trial court found appellant no longer desires to prosecute his appeal.

On the basis of that finding, this court has considered the appeal without briefs. See TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(b). We find no fundamental error.

Accordingly, the judgment of the trial court is affirmed.
