The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, April 6, 2011, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Karen Angelini, and Justice Marialyn Barnard.

The following case will be presented:

Dalal Hibri Monroe v. David Allen Monroe – This appeal arises out of a divorce proceeding and raises challenges to the trial court's property division.

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, April 7, 2011, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Karen Angelini, and Justice Marialyn Barnard.

The following case will be presented:

In re Guardianship of O.P., an Incapacitated Person - Mary Pena, O.P.'s guardian, appeals the trial court's granting of Jesus Patlan Jr.'s no-evidence and traditional motion for summary judgment. The main issue in this appeal is whether the time a case is pending before being dismissed for want of prosecution should be considered in determining whether, in a subsequent suit, an adequate time for discovery has passed under Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 166a(i).
