## **Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument**

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in two appeals on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Karen Angelini, Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, and Justice Phylis J. Speedlin.

The following cases will be presented:

Winder Amedalio Morales v. State – Appellant was found guilty of the misdemeanor offense of Driving While Intoxicated. On appeal, he argues the trial court erred in admitting the result of a blood draw taken 5 ½ hours after the time of driving and in allowing improper retrograde extrapolation testimony.

Bobby and Joyce Seguin v. Bexar Appraisal District and Appraisal Review Board and Chief Appraiser Michael Amezquita - Bobby and Joyce Seguin appeal the trial court's granting of the motions for summary judgment filed by Bexar Appraisal District, Appraisal Review Board, and Chief Appraiser Michael Amezquita. The main issue in this appeal is whether a disabled veteran who is not a resident of Texas is entitled to a property tax exemption under Section 11.22 of the Texas Tax Code.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
