ORDER

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this day came to be considered **Defendant's Motion to Declare Plaintiff as a Vexatious Litigant.** After considering the pleadings of the parties filed herein and the argument of counsel, the Court is of the opinion that the motion is meritorious and that the following order should issue:

It is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff Kenneth Ford, TDCJ-ID No. 588298 is hereby DETERMINED TO BE A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT.

THEREFORE, Plaintiff is ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$4,000⁰⁰. The amount must be furnished to the Court by July 15th 2003. Should Plaintiff fail to furnish such security within the time set by this Order, the above referenced and numbered cause is DISMISSED. Should the case be dismissed upon its merits, Plaintiff shall pay Defendant's reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation, including costs and attorney's fees.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall refuse the filing of any litigation presented by Kenneth Ford, TDCJ #588298 unless he obtains an order from the local administrative judge permitting the filing.

It is also FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System in accordance with Section

11.104(a) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.
