**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

On 3/8/12, the Court considered Defendant QuikTrip Corporation's Motion to Declare Plaintiff, LaKeith Amir-Sharif, a Vexatious Litigant and Request for Security. After considering the motion and after a hearing on the motion:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant's motion is GRANTED. Plaintiff is hereby declared a vexatious litigant. Plaintiff is ORDERED to furnish security to the court on or before 4/20/12, in the amount of \$ 2,500<sup>00</sup> to guarantee payment to Defendant for reasonable expenses incurred in or in connection with this litigation. If Plaintiff does not furnish security by 5:00 p.m. on the date set forth above, the Court shall dismiss this case in its entirety without prejudice.

The Court further ORDERS pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code §11.01 that Plaintiff is prohibited from filing, pro se, a new litigation in a court in this state.
