III. VENUE



IV. CAUSE OF ACTION

On or about August 10, 1999, JAHANE MARIE COTE (hereinafter referred to as "COTE") hired Respondent for representation in a claim against Allstate Insurance Company. On or about March 1, 2000, Respondent misrepresented to COTE that a lawsuit had been filed. In fact, Respondent delayed in filing the lawsuit until on or about December 11, 2000, under Cause No. 2000-62592, *Jahane Cote v. Allstate Insurance Company and Allstate Indemnity Company*, In the 215th Judicial District Court of Harris County, Texas.

During the course of the representation, COTE made several inquiries as to the status of the case. Respondent either failed to respond to COTE's inquiries or misrepresented the status of her case. On or about July 11, 2000, after arriving at Respondent's office for a scheduled appointment, COTE discovered that the premises had been vacated. In a subsequent telephone conversation, Respondent confirmed the move and ended the call with an unfulfilled promise to contact COTE the following day. COTE's further efforts to communicate with Respondent were unsuccessful.





As a practical matter, we respectfully suggest that an inquiry be made as to whether the judge will be able to comply with the one hundred and eighty (180) day deadline by which the case must be set for trial as set forth in Section 3.07 of the TEXAS RULES OF DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE. If not, we respectfully request that an alternate appointment be made.

Once a trial judge has been appointed, please forward the original and two (2) copies of the *Original Disciplinary Petition*, the *Civil Case Information Sheet*, the filing fee check (all enclosed herewith), and the *Court's Appointing Order* to the District Clerk of Harris County, Texas, with the request that the suit be filed, service be obtained, and a file-marked copy of the petition be returned to the undersigned.
