


**ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT
Of TEXAS**

IT IS ORDERED by the Supreme Court of Texas that the following, Rule IX (B), RE-APPLICATION TO TAKE EXAMINATION, be **eliminated** from the *Standards and Rules for Certification of Certified Shorthand Reporters* as adopted and promulgated in conformity with Chapter 52 of the Texas Government Code as follows:


- B. ~~If the applicant is unsuccessful on three successive examinations, the applicant may not take the next succeeding examination; if the applicant is unsuccessful on subsequent examinations, the applicant may not take the next succeeding examination following each unsuccessful examination.~~


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Supreme Court approves the elimination of Rule IX (B) to become effective September 1, 2001.




