AFFIDAVIT


I, **Rodney Dean Cooper**, presently residing at 3305 Pine Grove Dr, Midland, MI hereby solemnly affirm that:

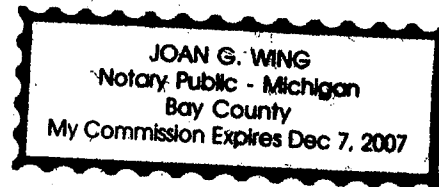
1. I have surrendered all Bar Cards, all Law Licenses, and all certificates currently in my possession that were issued to me by the Supreme Court of Texas.
