
ORDER OF THE COURT APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FY 1992-1993
GENERAL FUND BUDGET OF THE
STATE BAR OF TEXAS


WHEREAS, the State Bar of Texas has, by petition filed with the Clerk of this Court on October 6, 1992, 1992, petitioned the Supreme Court of Texas to approve an amendment to its fiscal year 1992-1993 general fund budget in an amount not to exceed \$89,975 and to approve the action of the Board of Directors to add 2½ newly created positions of Staff Attorneys and 1 legal secretary within the Office of the General Counsel.


WHEREAS, the petition has been presented to and considered by the Supreme Court of Texas, and the Court being of the opinion that such budget amendment is necessary and should be approved as set forth herein;


It is, therefore, ORDERED that the proposed amendment to the budget of the State Bar of Texas for fiscal year 1992-1993 as set forth in the petition of the State Bar of Texas and submitted to this Court be, and the same is hereby, APPROVED, and that such budget be amended, effective this date.

NOW COMES the State Bar of Texas, by and through the undersigned, and would respectfully represent to the Supreme Court of Texas the following:

I.

The Board of Directors of the State Bar of Texas, in a regularly called meeting on September 18, 1992, in Galveston, Texas, at which meeting a quorum was present, moved and adopted an amendment to the fiscal year 1992-1993 general fund budget in a amount not to exceed \$89,975 as follows:


Approve the actions to add 2½ newly created positions of Staff Attorneys and 1 legal secretary within the Office of the General Counsel to expand the litigation component.

Such positions could not have been reasonably foreseen nor anticipated at the time such budget was originally presented to the Supreme Court for approval in 1992.


WHEREFORE, the State Bar of Texas respectfully requests the Supreme Court of Texas approve this proposed amendment to its 1992-1993 budget.
