



Amendment to the Local Rules of the County Courts at Law of Bexar County, dated March 24, 1993.


The approval of these rules is temporary, pending further orders of the Court.



PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO LOCAL RULES

To Part II, Civil Section, Section II General Rules, of the Rules of Practice, Procedure and Administration in the County Courts of Bexar County, April 1991, add the following paragraph:

J. All civil cases filed in the Bexar County Courts at Law shall be filed in the Courts which give preference to the civil cases and in those Criminal Courts that participate as Civil Presiding Courts. The County Clerk shall without further Orders from the Courts, add or delete Courts from the filing rotation based upon their participation as Civil Presiding Court.


In accordance with Rule 3a of the Rules of Civil Procedure, the County Court at Law Judges of Bexar County, at a meeting held March 24, 1993, voted to amend the local rules of such courts as reflected by the enclosure, subject, of course, to the approval of the Supreme Court of Texas.

In brief, the amendment simply changes the manner in which civil cases are filed in the County Courts at Law. Currently, civil cases are assigned by computer rotation to all the Bexar County Courts at Law and then must be transferred to those courts which have civil dockets. The proposed amendment will simplify the filing and statistical tracking of civil cases in the Bexar County Courts at Law.

Notice of this proposed change in accordance with Rule of Civil Procedure 3a(4) is being given to the attorneys practicing before these courts contemporaneously with this letter.

Please advise if additional information is required. Otherwise, we shall await notification by the Court as to whether this change is approved.
