
ORDER

On this date, the Court considered Attorney General's Amicus Curiae Advisory to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant Pursuant to Chapter 11 & Advisory Recommending a Prefiling Order and the pleadings filed in the above-referenced case.

The Court finds Plaintiff Kevin Revels is a vexatious litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 500.00 by July 31, 2015 to proceed in this case. Failure to timely furnish security may result in dismissal of this suit.

Pursuant to Section 11.101 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further orders that Plaintiff be prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation in any court of this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. The Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System pursuant to Section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
