Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, February 4, 2016, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Luz Elena D. Chapa, and Justice Jason Pulliam.

The following case will be presented:

Shirley Hale Mathis, as Permanent Guardian of the Estate of Carlos Y. Benavides v. Leticia R. Benavides - Appellant Shirley Hale Mathis, as permanent guardian of the estate of Carlos Y. Benavides Jr., filed an "emergency motion to stop imminent release of supersedeas deposit per Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 24.4." Mathis argues the trial court erred by determining she was not entitled to supersede the underlying judgment during the pendency of this appeal. Appellee Leticia Benavides argues in response that the trial court's judgment may not be superseded because it is based on an obligation to pay temporary spousal maintenance during the pendency of a divorce proceeding.
