## Online Courses

From the home page, click on "Professionals", then click on "Continuing Education" in the dropdown menu. Each course identified for certified guardians is approved by the JBCC for 1.0 hour of continuing education. 1.0 hour in ethics is approved for the training "Financial Abuse of the Elderly." The provider requires payment of the fee and a completed feedback form to issue a certification of completion. All approved trainings may be used for guardianship continuing education **through June 30, 2016**.

Note:

Some courses may reference Guardianship Credit upon submission of an affidavit and a \$25 fee. This applies to individuals who are certified as Guardians Ad Litem, not to guardianship certification continuing education. Some courses may designate certain hours as "Guardianship" credit. Again, this refers to individuals who are certified as Guardians Ad Litem. Certified and provisionally certified guardians can earn continuing education hours as listed below for each course.
