The Office of Court Administration (OCA) recently used the Department of Information Resources' (DIR) established process to obtain the services of one contractor under the Information Technology Staff Augmentation Contract (ITSAC). A total of 10 vendors (including TIBH) were contacted and 12 resumes were received, 2 of which were from TIBH. Only 1 of the 2 TIBH candidates was deemed qualified but to our dismay, he accepted a job elsewhere before he could be interviewed. He was ranked near the top of the candidate list.

The Office of Court Administration (OCA) has determined that the "Best Value" for our agency would be to procure this service under Texas Government Code, Title 10, Subtitle D, Section 2155.067. OCA has selected a candidate from Allied Consultants, Inc. OCA has previously contracted with Allied for other IT projects and they have proven their ability to provide candidates with the skills necessary to successfully complete the job. The candidate selected has the background and experience required for the job and their hourly cost is well below our budgeted hourly rate. We also needed to quickly hire the contractor due to the rapidly approaching implementation date.
