The Sixth Court of Appeals is accepting resumes from law students who will be rising second- and third-year students during summer 2017 for unpaid judicial internship positions. The positions may be volunteer or for-credit.

The Sixth Court's intern program provides an opportunity to improve research and writing skills, while also providing a behind-the-scenes view of how an intermediate court of appeals works. Interns research factual and legal issues, review appellate records, perform substantive citation checks, write memoranda of law, discuss those memoranda with the judges and the Court's attorneys, observe the judges' discussions of issues in cases that are submitted, observe oral argument, and observe postsubmission resolution of legal issues raised in oral argument.

Please submit a resume and an unofficial law-school transcript, along with an indication of which summer session is preferred by **March 31, 2017**.
