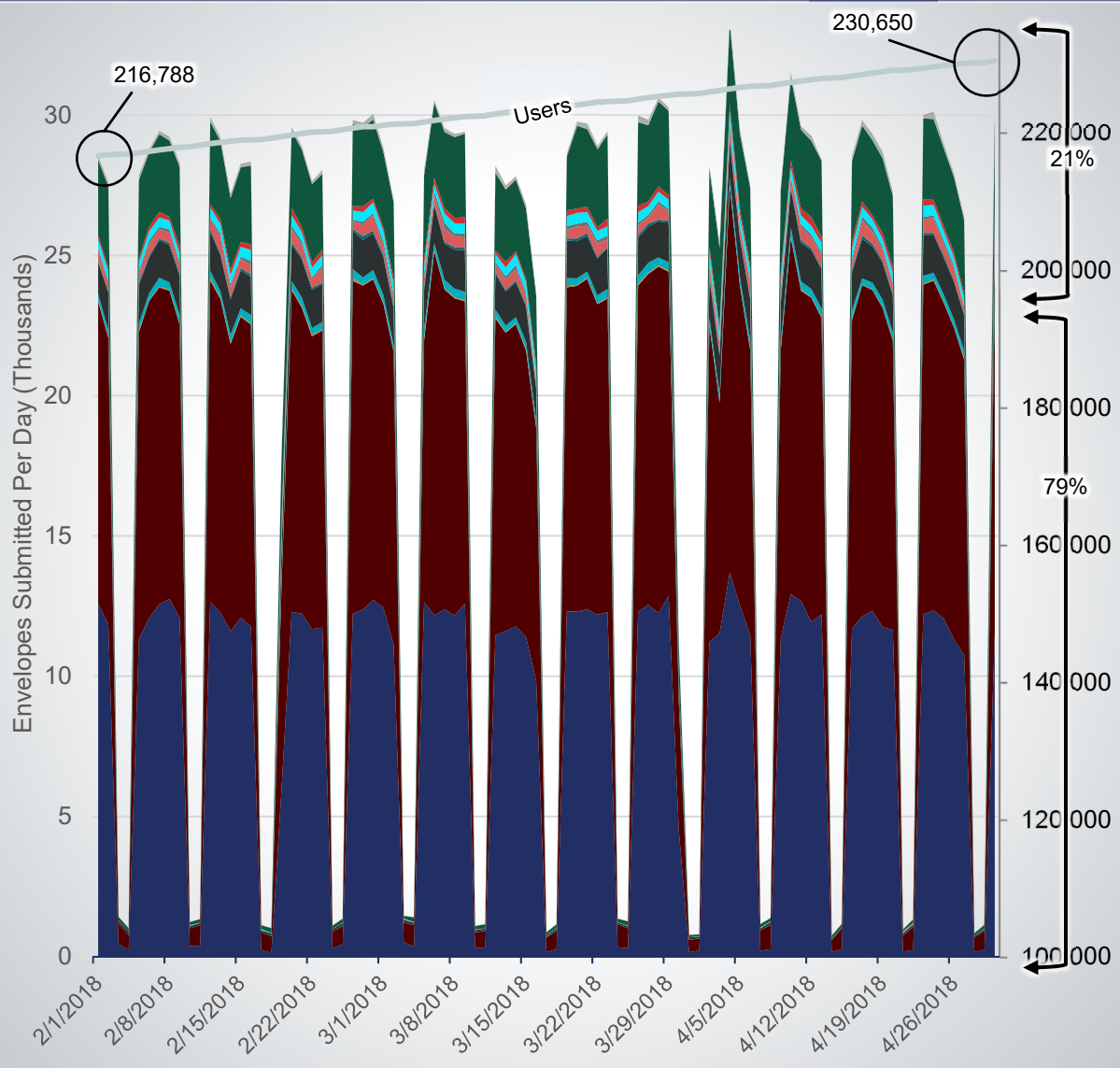

# Transaction Volume: 2/1/2018 to 4/30/2018



**Summary**

- Over 230k user accounts created to-date
- EFM currently receiving ~29,100 envelopes per day
- State filing portal accounts for 79% of transactions; remaining 21% stem from commercial EFSP submissions

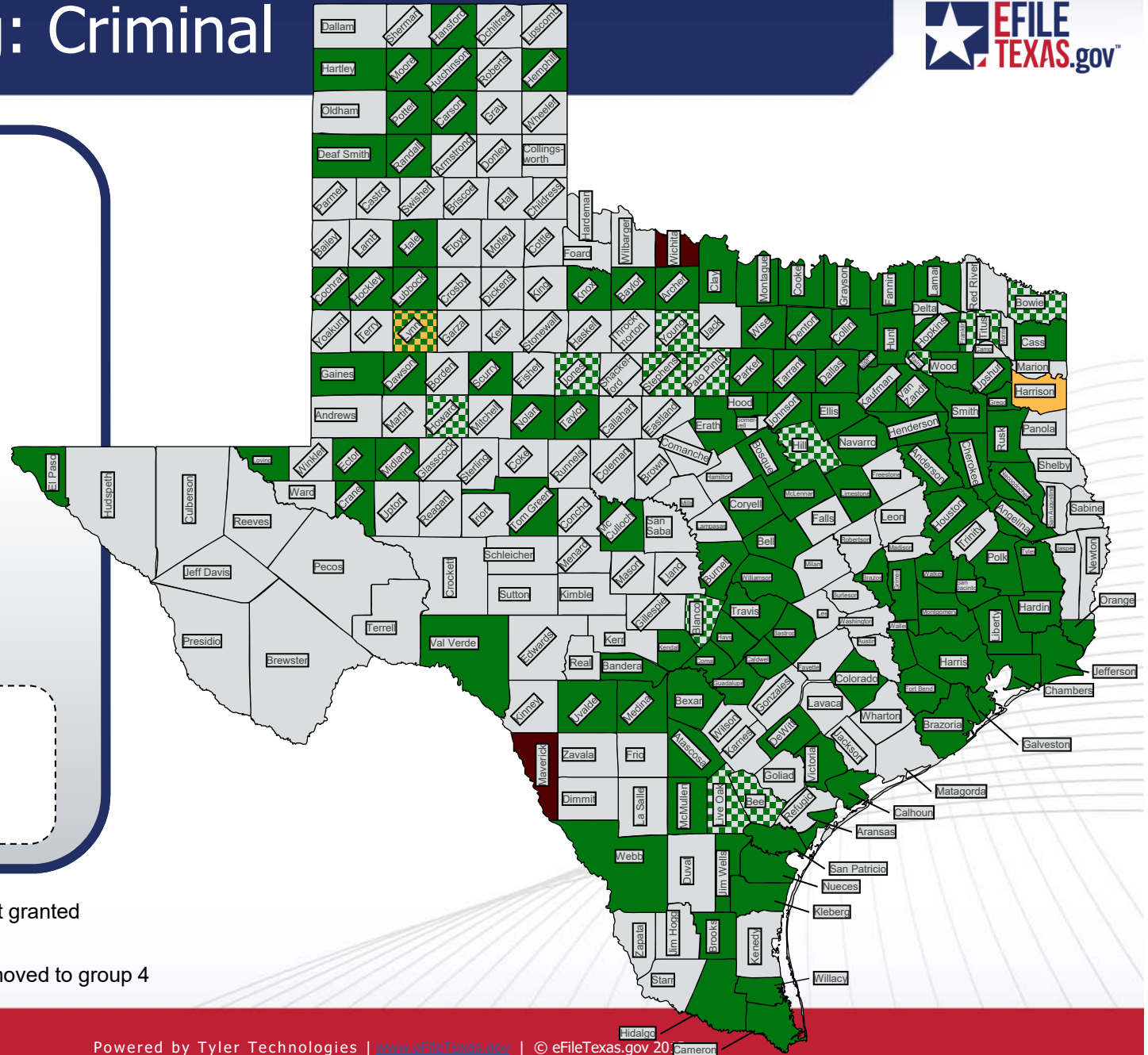

# Next Steps: Now through December



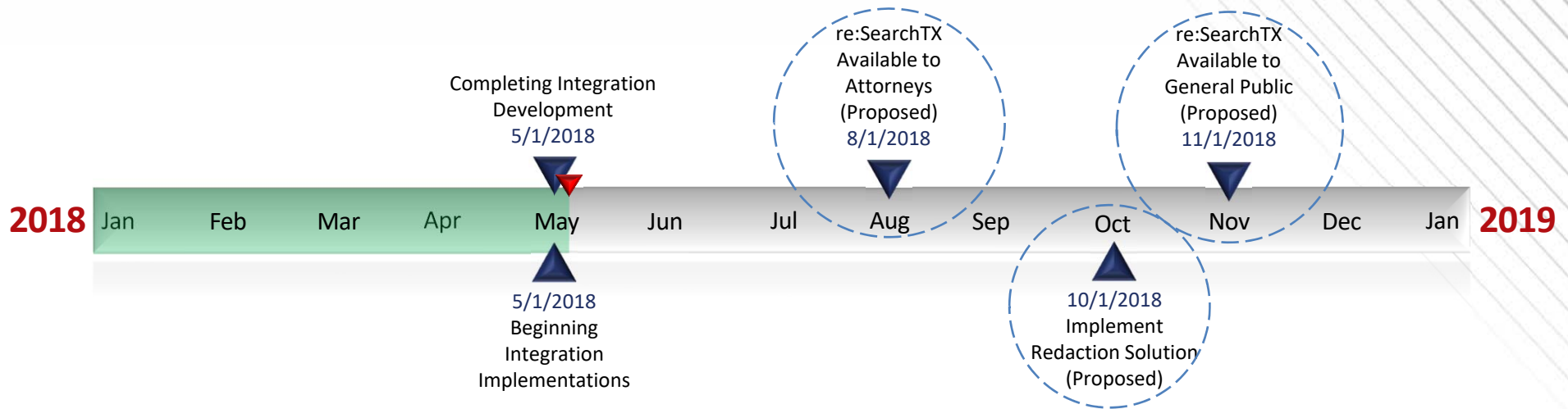
1. Continue the phased implementation rollout of criminal e-filing

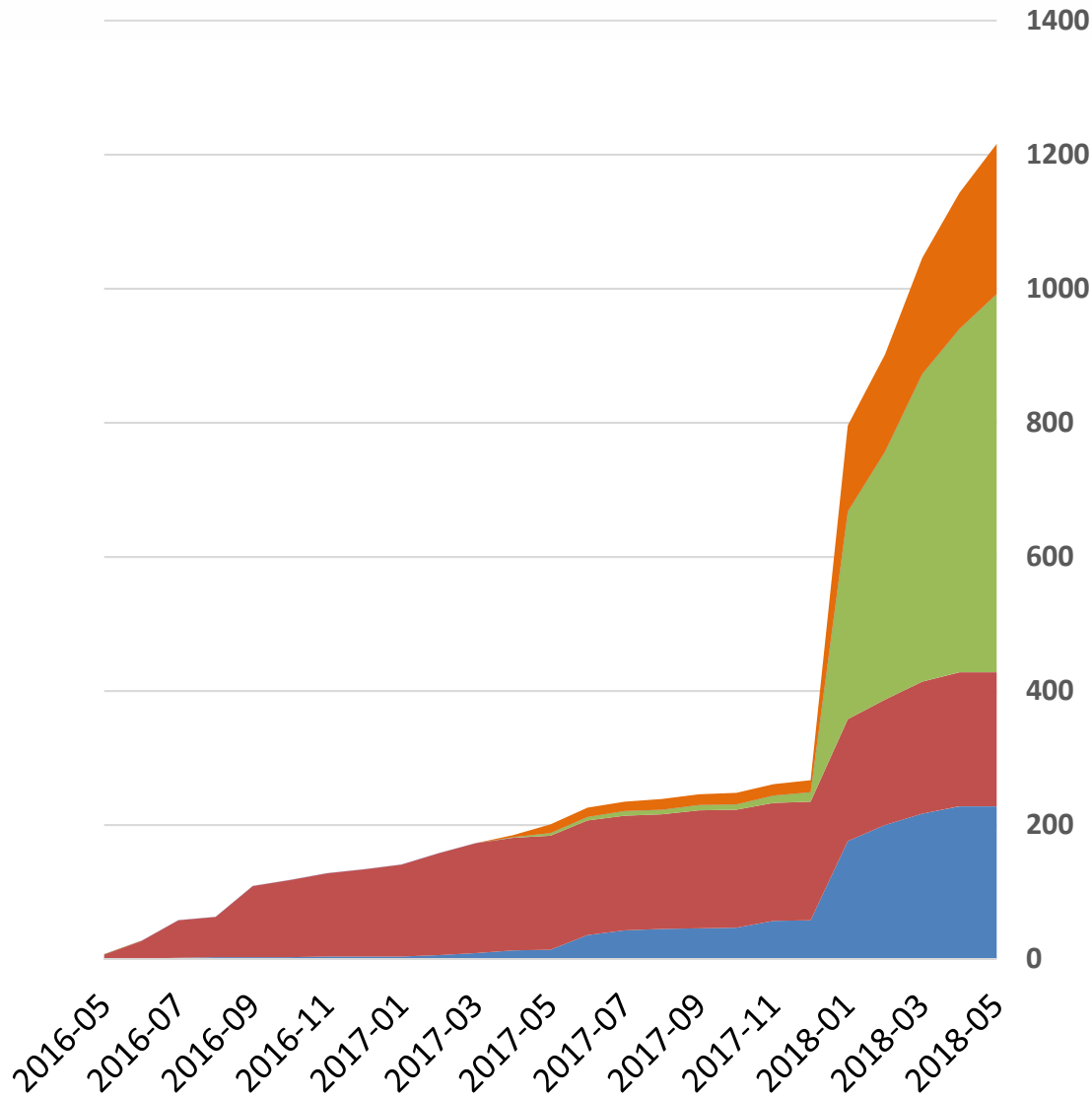
# re:SearchTX Project Timeline



## Summary

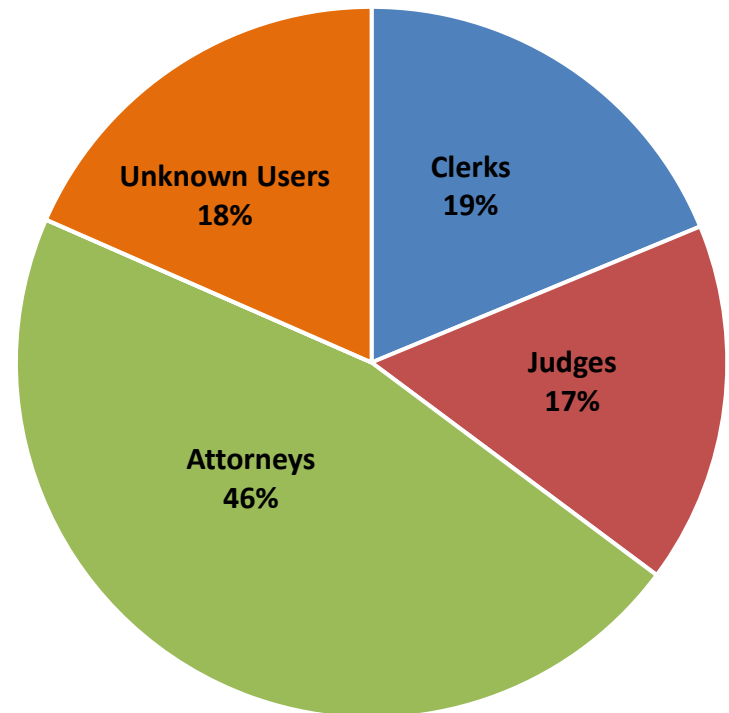
- JCIT working group last met on 4/6/18 to discuss re:SearchTX future direction
  - Meeting included a re:SearchTX product demonstration and overview of the proposed eFileTexas/re:SearchTX redaction solution
  - Redaction project is prerequisite to expanding re:SearchTX audience to the general public
- CMS Integration development work complete on 5/1/18
  - Pilot counties are completing final configuration and user acceptance testing
- Continuing outreach to the clerk community during the Clerk Association's Semi-Annual meeting (6/11/18) to drive awareness of broadened adoption and redaction solution
- Continue to update the Production environment on a monthly basis with new development

# re:SearchTX User Adoption



## Summary

- 1,029 users as of 5/1/18
  - 228 clerks
  - 200 judges
  - 564 attorneys
- 194 new attorneys since 3/1/18
- User counts expected to grow steadily as more become knowledgeable of solution
- 224 non-attorney users have attempted to access re:SearchTX since 1/1/18
