
On June 1, 2020, relator filed a petition for writ of mandamus and a motion for temporary relief pending final resolution of the petition for writ of mandamus. This court believes a serious question concerning the mandamus relief sought requires further consideration. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(b). The respondent and the real parties in interest may file a response to the petition in this court **no later than June 18, 2020**. Any such response must conform to Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 52.4.

Relator's request for temporary relief is GRANTED. The trial court's April 24, 2020 order (1) granting the real parties in interests' motion to compel and (2) compelling relator to produce certain "FedEx' Safety Council documents" by June 8, 2020 is STAYED pending final resolution of the petition for writ of mandamus.

It is so **ORDERED** on June 3, 2020.
