This cause was heard on the appellate record. Having considered the record, this Court holds that there was no error in the judgment requiring reversal, but there was error in the judgment capable of reformation. The Court **MODIFIES** the judgment by deleting \$234 in duplicative fees from the bill of costs, such that the total amount of court costs is only \$185 (instead of \$419).

The Court orders the judgment **AFFIRMED AS MODIFIED**.
