MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Jaime Apodaca seeks to appeal judgments of conviction for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, manslaughter, and aggravated family-violence assault with a deadly weapon. *See* Tex. Penal Code §§ 19.04 (manslaughter), 22.02(a)(2) (aggravated assault with a deadly weapon), 22.02(b)(1) (aggravated assault with a deadly weapon causing serious bodily injury to family member). The trial court has certified that (1) this is a plea-bargain case and Apodaca has no right of appeal, and (2) Apodaca has waived the right of appeal. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2), (d).
