Relator Vivian Garcia, as Independent Executrix of the Estate of Jesus Rodriguez Aguero, M.D., Deceased, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus in the above cause. By one issue, she asserts that the "Probate Court acted without jurisdiction and abused its discretion when it ordered an accounting under section 404.001(b) of the Texas Estates Code on the motion of litigants who lack statutory standing to obtain this relief," and therefore, "mandamus relief is warranted."

The Court requests that the real parties in interest, Charlotte Philbrick and Bruce Philbrick, or any others whose interest would be directly affected by the relief sought, file

a response to the petition for writ of mandamus on or before the expiration of ten days from the date of this order. See TEX. R. APP. P. 52.2, 52.4, 52.8.
