Appellants June Ok and T.T., a minor child, are attempting to appeal the trial court's order, signed March 28, 2019, granting Amy Joelyn Queen's "Amended Second Motion for Summary Judgment" and ordering "that Plaintiff June Ok's claims against Defendant Amy Joelyn Queen are hereby dismissed with prejudice to the refiling of same, and that Plaintiff June Ok take nothing from Defendant Amy Joelyn Queen by this suit." However, the record reflects that T.T. filed suit individually on his own behalf, even though the pleadings represent that he is a minor child, and the order granting summary judgment does not adjudicate the claims brought by T.T.

Therefore, the March 28, 2019 order granting Queen's "Amended Second Motion for Summary Judgment" is not an appealable order because it does not adjudicate all parties and claims, and it contains no language of finality. *See Lehman v. Har-Con Corp.*, 39 S.W.3d 191, 200 (Tex. 2001).

This appeal may be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction unless a response is filed establishing this Court's jurisdiction within 15 days of the date of this order. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(a).

It is so ORDERED.
