This Court today considered the motion for rehearing filed by appellee, the Department of Family and Protective Services. We order that the motion be **denied**. We order that this Court's judgment of March 5, 2020 be **vacated, set aside, and annulled**. We further order that this Court's memorandum opinion of March 5, 2020 be **withdrawn**.

This case is an appeal from the final order signed by the trial court on August 21, 2019. After submitting the case on the appellate record and the arguments properly raised by the parties, the Court holds that there was reversible error in the portion of the trial court's order terminating appellant's parental rights. Accordingly, the Court **reverses** that portion of the trial court's order and **remands** the case to the trial court for a new trial.

The Court **orders** that this decision be certified below for observance.
