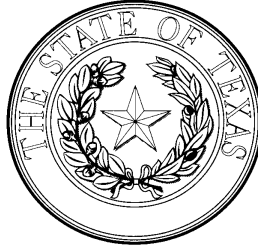

**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Gilberto Gonzales, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus, asking this Court to vacate the trial court's order that denied his no evidence motion for summary judgment and motion to strike and to enter an order that the

responsibility of a designated unknown responsible third party shall not be submitted to the jury.<sup>1</sup>

We **deny** relator's petition for writ of mandamus. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
